Workshop on Institutional Restructuring of Higher Education in Asia

This Workshop was the second phase of the Research Project on Institutional Restructuring of Higher Education in Asia, coorganised by the International Institute of Educational Planning (IIEP) of UNESCO and SEAMEO RIHED. Its purpose was to provide a forum for research teams from five Asian countries who had completed data collection and data analysis on institutional restructuring of their own institutions to present and discuss upon their research findings. The five participating countries with their research teams were listed as follows:

Indonesia: Prof. Dr. Sahid Susanto, and Dr. Nizam of Gadjah Mada University

Malaysia : Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ya<mark>h</mark>aya, and Asst. Prof. Imron Ho Abdulla of Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia

Mongolia : Ms. Yadmaa Narantsetseg, and Dr. Lida Boldbaatar of Mongolian University of Science and Technology

Thailand: Assoc. Prof. Banterng Suwantrakul of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Vietnam: Prof. Dr. Nguyen Vien Tho, and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Huynh Din Chien of Hue University

The discussion following each presentation, led by Dr. N.V. Varghese of IIEP who was aimed at clarification of some findings and addition or revision of the reports to make sure that they cover all intended topics. The final version of the research report containing all five cases is to be presented and discussed upon in the final workshop to be held next year.

The second batch comprising 49 university staff members received training on 6-23 October 2003, while the third batch comprising 51 staff members received training on 27 October-13 November 2003. The Project was supported by the Association of Universities and Colleges, Canada (AUCC), the Ministry of Education and Training (MOET), Vietnam, and the Strategic Consulting Group International, Vietnam.

They learned how to establish linkages with employers and how to match student skills with employer demands. They also gained knowledge on creating job and employer data bases and how to improve resume writing and job search skills.

This Seminar was co-organised by Burapha University and SEAMEO RIHED with the main objectives to (1) explore and discuss differring approches to long range and strategic planning for higher education institutions; (2) consider key planning methodologies including SWOT analysis, setting mission statements and objectives, and specifying strategies to achieve objectives; (3) explore approaches to plan implementation and evaluation; and (4) identify key planning tools that can be used, especially for generating information and undertaking analysis.

Prof. Dr. Suchart Upatham, President of Burapha University presided over the Opening Ceremony. Prof. Dr. Grant Harman and Assoc. Prof. Kay Harman from the University of New England, Australia served as resource persons for the Seminar.

Around 100 Seminar participants included top and middle level administrators of higher education institutions in Eastern Thailand and graduate students in doctoral programmes. The seminar activities included lecturing, panel discussion, small group discussion, and analysis of examplar strategic plans.
